

Yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified yarn and tension is used.				
MATERIALS				
1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 - USA6) PONY Knitting Needles ½ metre of fabric for lining. Handles, code BH3, available from Groves and Banks Stockists. Ring 01844 258130 for your nearest stockist or e-mail sales@groves-banks.com				
TENSION				
22 sts and 32 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension. Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.				
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.				

ABBREVIATIONS
cm centimetres
mm millimetres
in inch(es)

Note - bag is worked sideways rather than upwards, so the cast - on and cast - off edges will form the side seams.

SMALL BAG

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 88 stitches.

1st Row. Knit to end of row.

2nd Row. Purl to end of row.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as stocking stitch.

Working in stocking stitch (throughout) continue until work measures 20cm, (8in), finishing after a purl row.

Cast off 88 stitches knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Fold work in half. Join side seams leaving 10cm, (4in), open at top. Fold open edge over handle and stitch in place. Using bag as a guide cut a lining and stitch in place inside knitted bag. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.



LARGE BAG

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 124 stitches.

1st Row. Knit to end of row.

2nd Row. Purl to end of row.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as stocking stitch. Working in stocking stitch (throughout) continue until work measures 28cm, (11in), finishing after a purl row. Cast off 124 stitches knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Fold work in half. Join side seams leaving 10cm, (4in), open at top. Fold open edge over handle and stitch in place. Using bag as a guide cut a lining and stitch in place inside knitted bag. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
