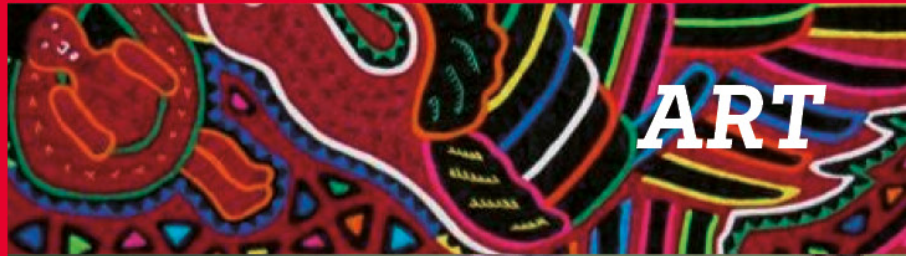

Colombia: Language, Nature and Peace - Summer Course

The objective of this Summer School Program is for international students to learn or improve their Spanish language skills while discovering Colombia through history, art, biodiversity including issues of conflict and peace. The total program is **102 hours** and each track (course with **3 Uniandes credits**). Students can choose to attend one or both tracks.

The University program takes place on our main campus in Bogotá, and includes a variety of extracurricular activities (guided visits to museums, trips and cultural activities, etc.) over the course of the summer.

June 5th – June 29th

Academic program: The Summer School offers two academic tracks, Spanish language and Colombia

Track 2: Spanish as a foreign language

For this track, students will take Spanish lessons in different levels (beginners, intermediate, advance) according to their Spanish skills which will be assessed through the Spanish placement exam. Over the course of 51 contact hours, students complete an intensive language program including Spanish language classes, and workshops. Successful completion of this course awards students three (3) Uniandes credits where one (1) credit equals 48 workload hours.

Track 1: Colombia: Art, biodiversity, history and peace.

This track comprises four (4) content modules in areas relevant to Colombia as follows: **Art, biodiversity, history and peace.** The objective of this complete track is for students to learn and get to know Colombia by attending lectures in English and having academic field trips related to these topics. Successful completion of this course awards students three (3) Uniandes credits where one (1) credit equals 48 workload hours.

Visa Information

The procedure regarding the permit to enter Colombia PIP or student visa you should keep the following aspects in mind:

·If you are coming for only for the summer program (fewer than 180 days), and if you are a citizen of a country which does not require a tourist visa to enter Colombia, you can request a PIP (Permiso de Ingreso al Pais).

·If you are coming for the summer program (fewer than 180 days), but you are a citizen of a country which requires a tourist visa to enter Colombia, you should request a student visa. If you are not sure whether your nationality requires a visa, please check [here](#) the list of countries that need a visa.
