we're delighted to share a little piece of our world with you.

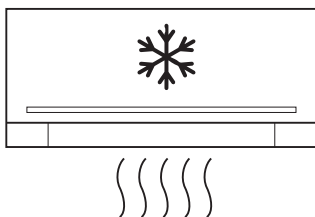

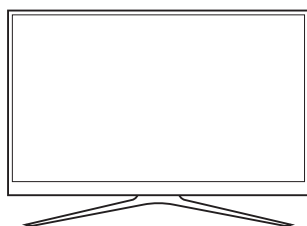
GUIDE D'INSTRUCTIONS:



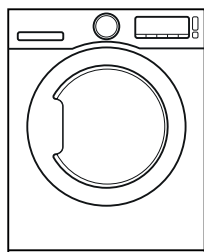
- 1 Press the yellow ON/OFF button, the air conditioner may take up to 5 minutes to start.
- 2 Check that the 2 air conditioners are in the same mode («Cold» for example) and select the mode that suits you best.
- 3 Set the temperature using the arrows.



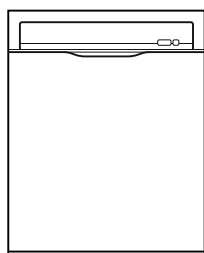
- 1 Use the "XIAOMI" remote control and press the ON button.
- 2 90 available channels visible or connect to Netflix, Amazon prime video or any other device with your account
- 3 If the outside light is too strong, you can close the blackout curtains



- 1 There are 2 remote controls: 1 for switching on the TV and 1 to switch on the decoder to view TNT channels.
- 2 You can watch over 90 French channels and some English channels (CNN, for example)



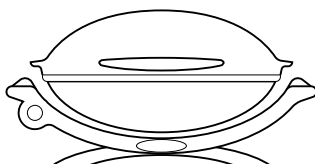
- 1 Add the detergent found under the black bathroom cabinet.
- 2 Select your program using the dial, temperature and spins per minute
- 3 Start the machine with the ON/OFF button.



- 1 Place a cleaner tablet in the opening tray.
- 2 Press the ON button, select program (Recommendation: AUTO 45-65°),
- 3 Press Start and close the door to start the dishwasher.



- 1 **Japanese WC control** • Select one of the 3 available modes.
- 2 Use the +, -, >, < controls to adjust spray intensity and temperature.
- 3 Press the red square button to stop the water jet.



- 1 Barbecue on the terrace with its protective cover.
- 2 Plug-in electric barbecue:
- 3 check that the aluminium grease container is present.
